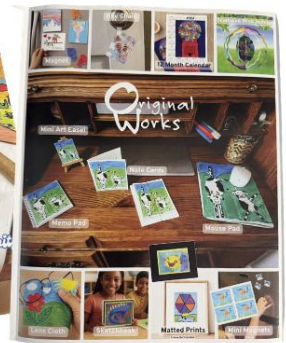

Please follow the instructions below to view/print the payment history for the current tax year.

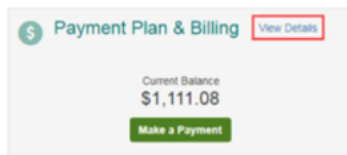
Step 1: FACTS Customer will sign into FACTS at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4BQ>

Step 2: Click on “Financial” from the menu on the left hand side of the page.

Step 3: Click on “Financial Home” in the Financial Links on the right of the screen.

Step 4: The customer will click on View Details.

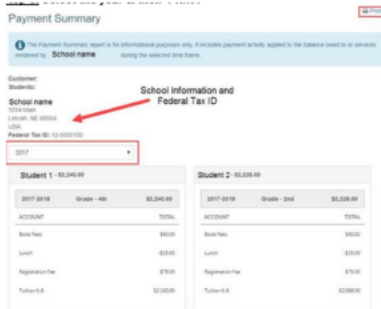
If you do not have an active FACTS Agreement, you may need to select “View Completed Activity Data” to be able to see your previous agreements.
